She was a shy person in the beginning but very attentive in the class. The classes on Life Skill and EDP helped her to open up and soon she became friendly with everyone. She was very hardworking. At the completion of the course she was placed in KITES, Bangalore. The agency is giving home care service to the sick and the elderly in Bangalore. She is happy to be there. In the beginning she was receiving 10,000/- as a monthly salary. Now at present she is getting 12,500/- as a monthly salary along with food and lodging is free of cost. She is grateful to PKRVTC for giving the training and FVTRS for supporting her for the training.
